How to Enter:

Aluminum, phone books, paper, books, newspaper, cardboard, plastics #1 & #2 only, magazines/catalogs, steel cans, glass, or any combination of these materials.

Small amounts of non-recyclable fasteners such as glue and tape are only permitted to use as fasteners

Recycle Art Contest Rules:

1. All materials used in artwork MUST be able to be recycled (exceptions are glue and tape).
2. Contest open to CSU students, faculty and staff
3. Fully completed entry form must accompany all artwork.
4. Entries must be handmade.
5. Entries will be accepted at Lakeside Dining Hall on Friday, April 14th between 7:30 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
6. All materials used in artwork must be clean and safe (ex. no dirty containers or sharp edges).
7. More than one artist can be listed on a single entry.
8. Judging will be based on the artwork's creativity and the artist's adherence to these contest rules.
9. Artwork will be judged on creativity and the Grand Prize will be Bike! Runner-up prizes also awarded.
10. Winners will be announced at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, April 24th at Lakeside Dining Hall and contacted by phone and/or e-mail.
11. Artwork will be on display through Friday, April 21st.

Recycle Art Competition Frequently Asked Questions

1. **What is the goal of the Recycle art competition?**
The goal of the Recycle art competition is to encourage the CSU Community to explore positive ways to change our relationship with the environment, while expressing their creativity and artistic talents.
2. **What is the target audience for this competition?**
Clayton State University faculty, staff and students
3. **Do I have to be a student to enter?**
No.
4. **Can we enter the art competition as a group?**
Yes, however all individuals must meet the contest qualification requirements – see the list of rules above for details. In order to submit group artwork, all artists must be either: faculty, staff or students, but not professional artists.
5. **Will I get my art returned to me?**
Yes. Art entries will be on display through Friday, April 21st at 5:00 p.m., otherwise they will be recycled.
6. **Can I take a photo of my artwork and send that as my entry?**
Photos of artwork do not qualify as legitimate entries.
7. **Can I make a collage using old bottles, cans and litter?**
Yes, you can combine any of the listed recycle materials on the entry form.
